

The Integrity and Compliance program promotes compliance with all relevant laws, regulations, policies and standards. The Code/Standard of Conduct applies to:


- Providence St. Joseph Health (PSJH) and their workforce members

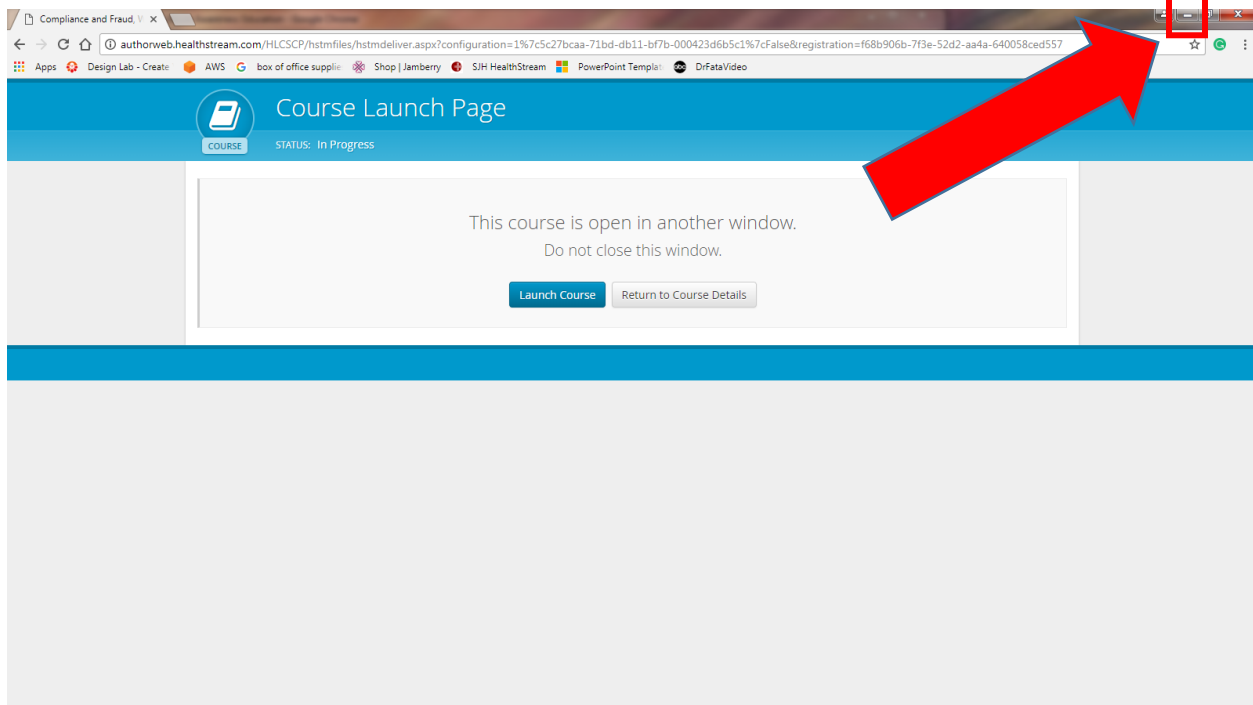

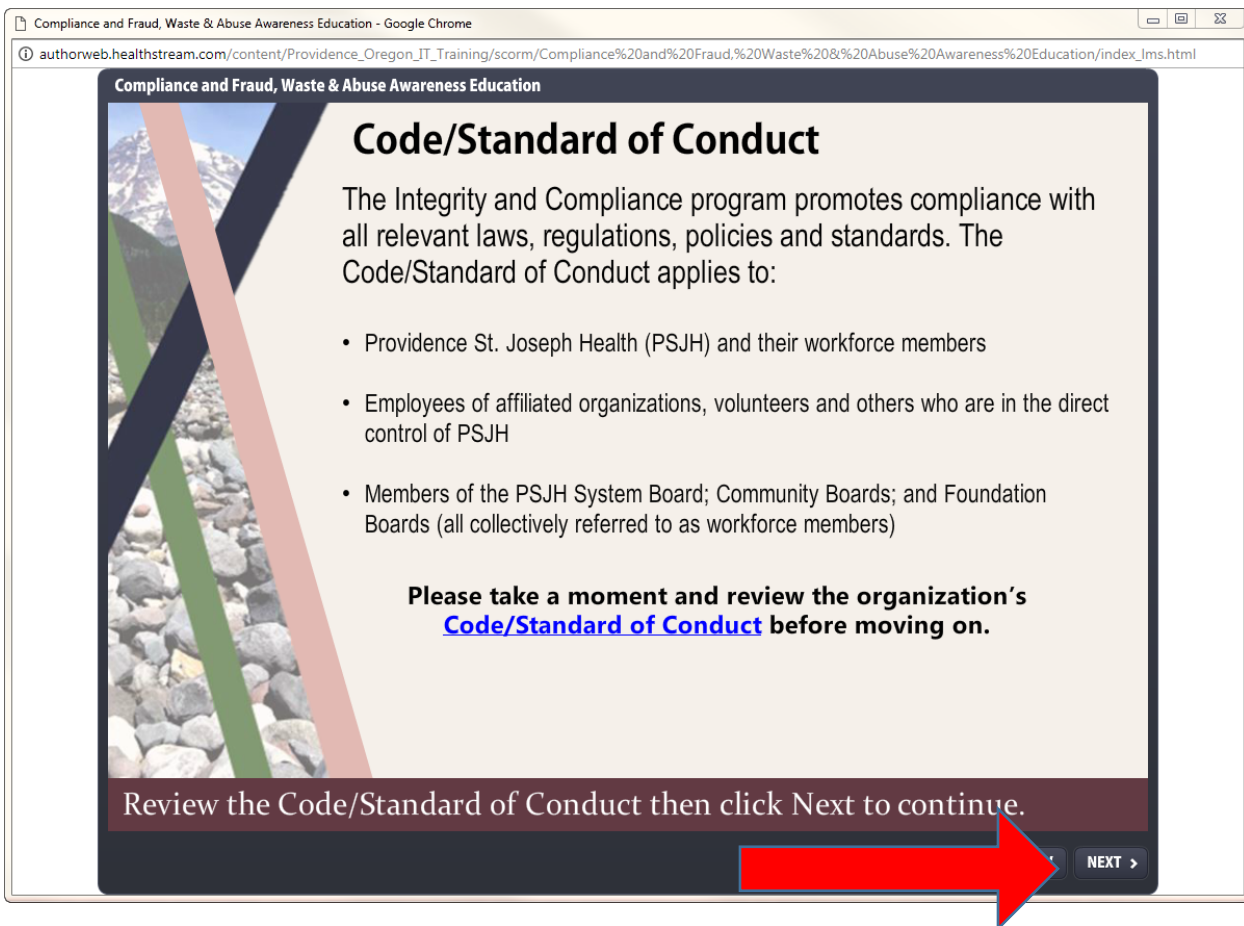
