

Get ready for mandatory appropriate use criteria for advanced imaging

Beginning **January 1, 2020**, providers who order advanced diagnostic imaging services for Medicare patients must consult appropriate use criteria (AUC) through a qualified clinical decision support mechanism (CDSM) prior to submitting the order.

How to submit imaging orders to our facilities for Medicare patients

For advanced imaging studies, consulting the AUC is **required** by CMS and PAMA for all orders, both internal and external. To comply, we have integrated [National Decision Support Company's CareSelect](#) into our electronic health records (EHR) to consult evidence-based clinical guidelines solutions for diagnostic imaging.

For our external providers who do not have access to our EHR, there are three options available when submitting a referral to us:

3. For high frequency external providers, access to Epic CareLink is available.
