# **Frequently Asked Questions**

## Will this testhurt?

No, the nasal swab is not sharp and it should not hurt. Sometimes the swab can feel slightly uncomfortable or tickly. If you feel pain, please stop the test and seek advice from a healthcare provider.

## What are the known and potential risks and benefits of this test?

### Potential risks include:

- Possible discomfort during sample collection.
- Possible incorrect test results (see Results section).

## Potential benefits include:

- The results, along with other information, can help your healthcare provider make informed recommendations about your care.
- The results of this test may help limit the spread of COVID-19 to your family and others in your community.

## What is the difference between an antigen and molecular test?

There are different kinds of tests for COVID-19. Molecular tests(alsoknown asPCR tests) detect genetic material from the virus. Antigen tests detect proteins from the virus. Antigen tests are very specific for the virus, but are not as sensitive as molecular tests. This means that a positive result is highly accurate, but anegative result does not rule out infection. If your test result is negative, you should discuss with your healthcare provider whether an additional molecular test would help with your care, and when you should discontinue home isolation.

## How Accurate is thisTest?

Basedon the interimresultsofa clinical studywherethe BinaxNOW<sup>™</sup> COVID-19 Ag Card 2 Home Test was compared to an FDA authorized high sensitivity SARS-CoV-2 test, BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card 2 Home Test correctly identified 91.7% of positive specimens and 100% of negative specimens.



# **Frequently Asked Questions**

Due to the relatively small sample size for the home use clinical study, the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card 2 Home Test is estimated to correctly identify between 73.0% and 98.9% of positive specimens as reflected in the 95% Confidence Interval. This is consistent with the performance established in a separate multi-site clinical study in the US, where the BinaxNOWCOVID-19 Ag Card test was performed and results interpreted by test operators with no laboratory experience. In that study, BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card test correctly identified 84.6% of positive specimens and 98.5% of negative specimens.

The performance of this test is still being studied in patients without signs and symptoms of respiratory infection and for serial screening. Performance may differ inthese populations.

Based on this information, negative results may require additional testing to confirm your result. Please talk to your healthcare provider to determine if you need additional testing.

### What is Serial Testing?

COVID-19 Serial testing is when one person tests themselves multiple times for COVID-19 on a routine basis, such as every day or every other day. By testing more frequently, you may detect COVID-19 more quickly and reduce spread of infection.



# Indication

The BinaxNOWCOVID-19AgCard 2HomeTestisalateral flow immunoassay intended for the qualitative detection of nucleocapsid protein antigen fromSARS-CoV-2 in directanterior nasal (nares) swabs from individuals with or without symptoms or other epidemiological reasons to suspect COVID-19 infection when tested twice over three days with at least 36 hours between tests. This test is authorized for home use with self- collected observed direct anterior nasal (nares) swab samples from individuals aged 15 years or older or adult collected nasal swab samples from individuals aged two years or older.

The BinaxNOW COVID-19 AgCard 2 Home Testistobe performed only with the supervision of a telehealth proctor.

The BinaxNOW COVID-19AgCard 2Home Test does not differentiate between SARS-CoV and SARS-CoV-2.

Results are for the identification of SARS-CoV-2 nucleocapsid protein antigen. Antigen is generally detectable in anterior nasal (nares) swabs during the acute phase of infection. Positive results indicate the presence of viral antigens, but clinical correlation with past medical history and other diagnosticinformation is necessary to determine infection status. Positiveresults do not rule out bacterial infection or co-infection with otherviruses. The agent detected maynot be the definite cause of disease. Individuals who test positive with the BinaxNOW

COVID-19 Ag Card Home Test should self-isolate and seek follow-up care with their physician or healthcare provider as additional testing may be necessary.



Negative results should be treated as presumptive and confirmation with a molecular assay, if necessary, for patient management, may be performed. Negative results do not rule outSARS-CoV-2 infection and should not be used as the sole basis for treatment or patient management decisions including infection control decisions. Negative results should be considered in the context of a patient's recent exposures, history and the presence of clinical signs and symptoms consistent with COVID-19. For serial testing programs, additional confirmatory testing with a molecular test for negative results may be necessary, if there is a high likelihood of COVID-19, such as, an individual with a close contact with COVID-19 or with suspected exposure to COVID-19 or in communities with high prevalence of infection. Additional confirmatory testing with a molecular test for positive results may also be necessary, if there is a low likelihood of COVID-19, such as in individuals without known exposures to COVID-19or residing in communities with low prevalence of infection.

Individuals who test negative and continue to experience COVID-like symptoms of fever, cough and/or shortness of breath maystill have SARS-CoV-2 infection and should seek follow up care from their healthcare provider.

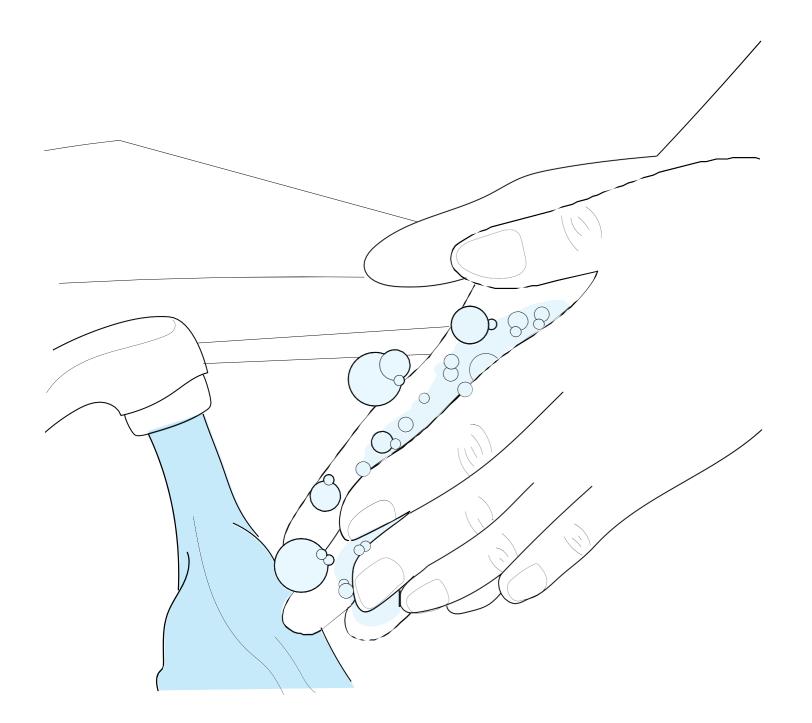

The BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card 2 Home Test is only for use under the Food and Drug Administration's Emergency Use Authorization.

The telehealth provider will report all test results they receive from individuals who use the authorized product to relevant public health authorities in accordance with local, state, and federal requirements using appropriate LOINC and SNOMEDcodes, as defined by the Laboratory *In Vitro* Diagnostics (LIVD)Test Code Mapping for SARS-CoV-2 Tests provided by CDC.

# **Check for Positive COVID-19 Result**

Find result window and look carefully for two pink/purple lines inwindow.

• **Positive Result:** Two pink/purple lines will appear. One on the tophalf and one on the bottom half. COVID-19 was detected.

# **Positive COVID-19Result**

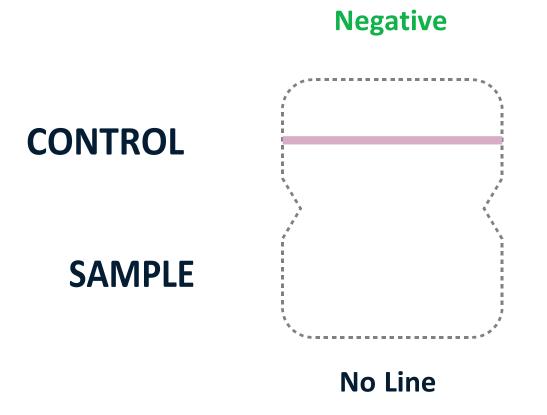
A positive test result means it is very likely you have COVID-19 and it is important to be under the care of your healthcare provider. The telehealth proctor is not a healthcare provider. It is also likely that you may be placed in isolation to avoid spreading the virus toothers. There is avery small chance that this test can give a positive result that is wrong (a false positive result). If you test positive with the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card 2 Home Test kit, you should self-isolate and seek follow-up care with your healthcare provider. Your healthcare provider will work with you to determinehow best to care for you based on your test result(s) along with your medical history, and your symptoms.

# **Negative COVID-19Result**

A negative test result means that proteins from the virus that causes COVID-19werenot foundin your sample.

It is possible for this test to give a negative resultthat is incorrect (false negative) in some people with COVID-19. This means that you could possiblystillhaveCOVID-19eventhough the test is negative. If you test negative and continue to experience COVID-19 like symptoms of fever, cough and/or shortness of breath you should seek follow up care with your healthcare provider. Please consult your healthcare professional if you develop symptoms, symptoms persist or become more severe. The telehealth proctor is not a healthcare provider. Your healthcare provider will consider the test result together with all other aspects of your medical history (such as symptoms, possible exposures, and geographical location of places youhave recently traveled) in deciding how to care foryou. For example, your healthcare provider may suggest you need another test to determine if you have contracted the virus causing COVID-19.

If you or the telehealth proctor disagree on the presence of a faint line and/or the presence of a line is uncertain, additional testing should be conducted.

It is important that you work with your healthcare provider to help you understand the next steps you should take.



## What do I needto know about Results from Serial Testing?

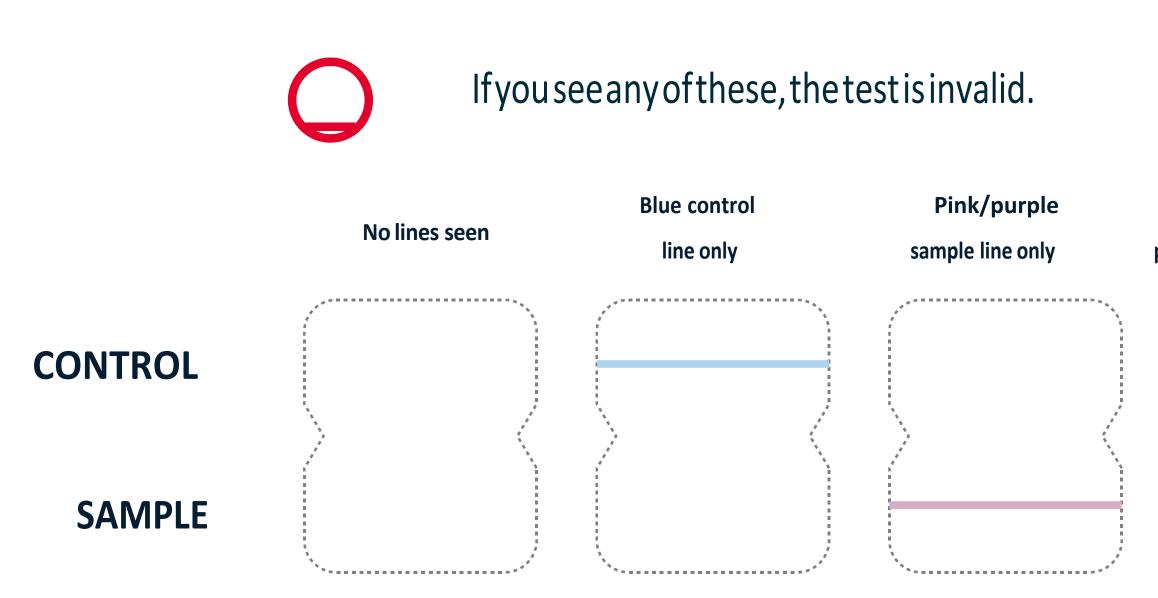
If your first test is negative, you should testagain in 24-36 hours.

If your first or second test is positive, then proteins from the virus that causes COVID-19have been found in your specimen and you likely have COVID-19. If you test positive with the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card 2 Home Test with either test, you should self-isolate and seek follow-up care with your healthcareprovider to determine the next steps you should take. You may need additional testing, depending on your personal health history and other factors.

If both your first and second tests are negative, you may not have COVID-19, however, you should follow-up with your healthcare provider if you are at high risk for COVID-19 infection or have known contacts with COVID-19. Your healthcare provider maysuggest you need another test to determine ifyou have contracted the virus causing COVID-19 or need other testing.





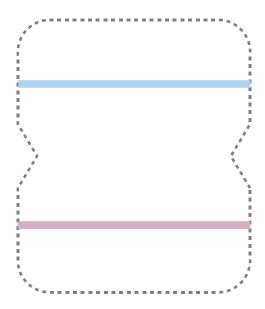

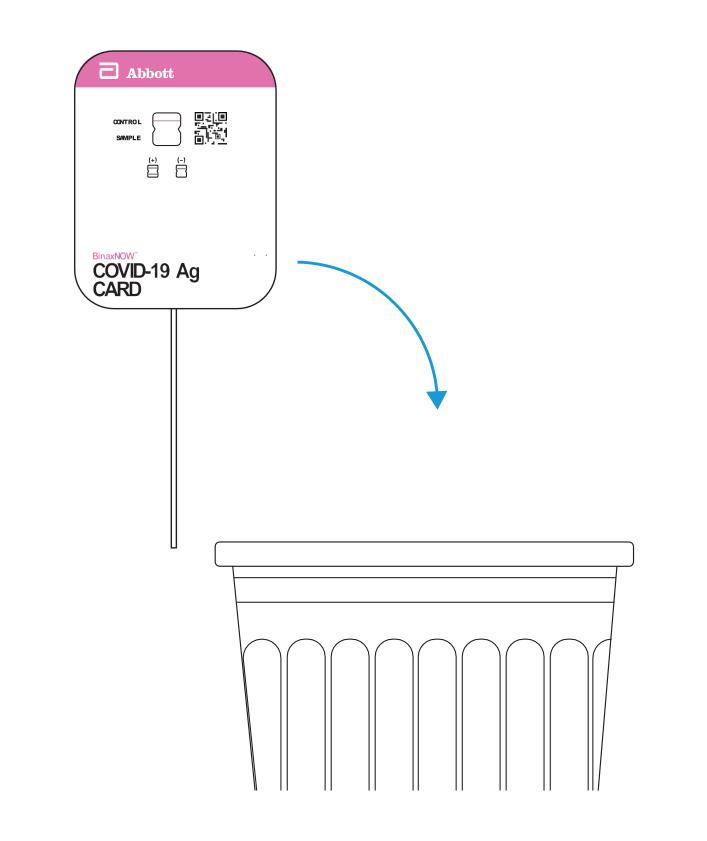
