CHS Plan for Fall Surges | Return-to-Work Criteria

Return to Work (RTW criteria differs by disease type and location (state and local health authority). The following outlines broad RTW plans for Fall '23.

Influenza

(WA, MT, TX, NM & OR)

COVID-19

Fever free for ≥ 24 hours w/o medication, symptoms resolving +7 days from symptom onset if CG works in

RTW, no additional requirements

Fever free for ≥ 24 hours w/o medication, symptoms resolving

5 days from positive test

transplant unit

May RTW on Day 6

- Use N95 mask thru Day 10 from symptom onset/positive test
- Social distance
- Eat alone

Fever free for ≥ 24 hours w/o medication, symptoms resolving

5 days from positive test

May RTW on Day 6 with negative test

- Use N95 through 10 days from symptom onset/positive test
- Social distance
- Eat alone

*Criteria may change over time due to local health authority requirements or changing community levels.



**Caregivers who test positive for COVID-19, with or without symptoms, must report to the CHS Call Center for guidance and clearance to return to work.
